## Seville Spanish Studies Program | Course Pre-Registration

The semester at SSA in Seville begins with a 3-week Intensive Period, with students enrolling in a 3-credit language course and a 1-credit language module. Students are also encouraged to enroll in SPAN 343 - Cultural Realities of Spain. Following the Intensive Period, students continue their semester with a full course schedule.

After consulting with your advisor, please choose courses following the guidelines below:

- 1. The prerequisites for this program are:
  - The successful completion of one course of intermediate college Spanish or the equivalent.
  - Minimum 2.75 GPA in Spanish coursework.
- 2. You must enroll in a minimum of 12 credits and a maximum of 18 credits for each semester. Advanced students may take additional credits with prior approval from their institution academic advisor and the Sevile Resident Director. Consult the <a href="SSA website">SSA website</a> (under the Choose Your Courses section) for individual course prerequisites.
- 3. Students are encouraged to enroll in SPAN 343 in their first semester at SSA. This course will run throughout the entire semester.
- 4. You must select a language class for the Intensive Period. You may indicate that you wish to be considered for SPAN 403, but must also select an alternate course, as registration for SPAN 403 is finalized after the placement test at the start of the program in Seville.
- 5. It is mandatory for all students to enroll in a 1-credit language module in the Intensive Period.
- 6. Students enrolling in SPAN 204 during the Intensive Period must select SPAN 205 as their language module.
- 7. Students enrolled in SPAN 204 during the Intensive Period must select SPAN 305B during the Continuation Period.
- Students enrolled in SPAN 204 during the Intensive Period are encouraged to enroll in SPAN 303/304, SPAN 317/318, SPAN 353/354, SOCI 351, or SPAN 362 during the Continuation Period. SSA recommends selecting one or two of these courses.
- 9. Heritage and/or native speakers are not allowed to enroll in the Listening (310L) or Speaking (310SP) modules.
- 10. If you select a 400-level course, you must have prior experience in a pertinent field of study; see descriptions and prerequisites in the SSA website.
- 11. The minimum enrollment for a course is five students.

12. Experiential Learning opportunities have a prerequisite of one course in advanced college Spanish prior to the program and are approved in Seville. You may indicate that you wish to enroll in an Experiential Learning opportunity, but must select a full course load from non-Experiential Learning courses during the Continuation Period, in the event that your selection is not approved.
