

## Barcelona Integrated Studies Program at Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF) | Course Pre-Registration

After consulting with your school academic advisor, please choose courses following the guidelines below:

- 1. The prerequisites for this program are:
  - o Minimum 3.0 overall GPA.
  - You must be a junior or senior in college.
  - If you are interested in taking content courses in Spanish, you must have completed two courses in advanced Spanish or the equivalent prior to the beginning of the program, and placed into at least a B1 level on the on-line placement test taken prior to arrival in Barcelona.
- 2. You must enroll in a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 18 credits per semester.
- 3. Students may select a Spanish language course.
- 4. Students may select three to five courses from a variety of tracks (click on links below to see courses for each track):
  - UPF regular content courses
  - Barcelona Interdisciplinary Program (BaPIS)
    - Fall Semester
    - Spring Semester
  - o Basic Biomedical Sciences
  - o <u>ESCI International Business Program</u>
- 5. Due to possible class schedule conflicts, we recommend you take most of your courses in the BaPis track and one content course in your field of interest (Humanities, Basic Biomedical Science, Business, etc.)
- When reviewing course offerings, note that credits follow the ECTS system of credits where 6 ECTS credits equal 3 U.S. credits.
- 7. Final confirmation of class schedules and courses takes place in Barcelona.
- 8. SSA and UPF reserve the right to cancel courses due to low enrollment.
- 9. Selecting courses at UPF can be confusing, be sure to meet with your SSA Student Services Advisor before you start this process.
