

## 2024 San Juan Integrated Summer Program | Course Pre-registration

After consulting with your home school advisor, please choose courses according to the following guidelines.

### Prerequisites:

1. Minimum 3.0 GPA in Spanish coursework.
2. Successful completion of four semesters of college Spanish or the equivalent prior to the program.

### Instructions:

1. Students enroll in 3-6 credits per term.
2. Students may take one or two content courses. After reviewing the content courses available at Universidad del Sagrado Corazón (USC) [here](#), enter the course codes and names of the courses in which you would like to enroll, as well as alternates for those courses.
3. Students may complement their content course(s) with a Spanish language course, internship, service learning, or independent research project for 3 credits each.
4. SSA reserves the right to cancel courses due to low enrollment.
