Instructions:

- 1. Students enroll in a 3-credit or 4-credit course per term, plus up to two Living the Culture courses per term. Please consult the <u>SSA website</u> (under the Choose Your Courses section) for individual course prerequisites.
- 2. Students may select LTC 491PS, Paddle Surf, for one summer term only.
- 3. Students may enroll in LTC491SVL Service Learning, or LTC491D Regional Folk Dance in both summer term 1 and summer term 2 or for just one term.
- 4. Please note that there are additional fees for LTC courses. Contact SSA for details.
- 5. SSA reserves the right to cancel courses due to low enrollment.
