## Course Preregistration

The semester begins with a 4-week Intensive Period, with students enrolling in a language class. Following the Intensive Period, students continue their semester with a full course schedule, enrolling in an additional two to three courses. After consulting with your school's academic advisor, choose courses according to the following guidelines.

### Prerequisite:

1. Minimum 2.75 GPA.
2. Consult the [SSA Website](#) (under the Academics section) for individual course prerequisites.

### Instructions:

1. Students must preregister for a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 18 credits over the Intensive and Continuation Periods.
2. Enrollment in Spanish language courses depends upon your score on the [Online Spanish Language Placement Exam](#).
3. Select one language course during the Intensive Period, according to your language level.
4. During the Continuation Period, students may select courses from the Culture Courses in English section and/or the Integrated Content Courses in English list.
5. Advanced students may take additional credits with prior approval from their school's academic advisor and the Alicante Resident Director. Most integrated courses meet for 45 or 60 hours per semester and equal 3 to 4 academic credits respectively.
6. To choose your integrated courses in English at the University of Alicante (UA), click [here](#). After reviewing the courses available, note the titles and codes of the UA courses in which you would like to enroll and alternates for each of those courses. You may take between one and three integrated courses at UA. For the purposes of this preregistration, assume all courses are worth 4 credits.
7. Internships and Living the Culture courses are approved in Alicante. Students may note their interest in these opportunities but must preregister for a full non-Experiential Learning course load during the Continuation Period.
8. Final exams take place several days or weeks after the last day of class but students are often able to schedule early exams with approval from their professor and should plan to coordinate these arrangements at the beginning of the semester.
9. There are additional fees for Living the Culture (LTC) courses. Contact SSA for details.
10. SSA reserves the right to cancel courses due to low enrollment.
