## Course Preregistration

After consulting with your school academic advisor, please choose courses following the guidelines below:

### Prerequisites:

1. Minimum 3.0 GPA
2. You must be a junior or senior in college.
3. If you are interested in taking **content courses in Spanish**, you must have completed two courses in advanced Spanish or the equivalent prior to the beginning of the program, and placed into at least a B1 level on the online Spanish language placement test taken prior to arrival in Barcelona.

### Instructions:

1. You must enroll in a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 18 credits per semester.
2. Due to possible class schedule conflicts, we recommend you take most of your Spanish language and content courses in the Barcelona Interdisciplinary Program track, and one content course in your field of interest (Communications, Economy, Business, etc.)

5. Final confirmation of class schedules and courses takes place in Barcelona.
