# Liberal Arts in Advanced Spanish | Academic Year 2024–2025

## Course Preregistration

After consulting with your school's academic advisor, choose courses according to the following guidelines.

### Prerequisites:

1. Minimum 3.0 GPA
2. The successful completion of two courses in advanced Spanish or the equivalent
3. B1 level score in the online Spanish language placement test

### Instructions:

1. You must enroll in a minimum of 12 credits and a maximum of 18 credits per semester at the SSA Center and the Universidad de Sevilla (USEV). Advanced students may take additional credits with prior approval from their institution academic advisor and the Seville Resident Director.
2. You are encouraged to enroll in SPAN 343 – Cultural Realities of Spain in your first semester at SSA. This course will run throughout the entire semester.
3. You must select a 3-credit language class. You may indicate that you wish to be considered for SPAN 403, but must also select an alternate course, as registration for this course is finalized after the placement test at the start of the program in Seville.
4. Heritage and/or native speakers are not allowed to enroll in the Listening (310L) or Speaking (310SP) modules.
5. To choose your courses at USEV, click [here](#). You may also click [here](#) to access a step-by-step guide on how to find courses and syllabi on USEV's website. After reviewing the courses available, enter the course codes and names of the one to two USEV courses in which you would like to enroll, as well as alternates for those courses. The majority of content courses at USEV meet 45–60 hours per semester and equal three to four credits respectively. For the purpose of this preregistration, assume all courses are worth three credits. We recommend taking a maximum of two courses at USEV.
6. Final registration in USEV courses takes place once you are in Seville.
7. Final exams at USEV follow a different schedule from that of the SSA Center. Students are often able to schedule early exams with approval from their USEV professors, and should plan to coordinate these arrangements at the beginning of the semester.
8. Experiential Learning opportunities have a prerequisite of one course in advanced college Spanish prior to the program and are approved in Seville. You may indicate that you wish to enroll in an Experiential Learning opportunity, but must select a full course load from non-Experiential Learning courses in the event that your selection is not approved.
9. SSA reserves the right to cancel classes due to low enrollment.
