Course Preregistration Guidelines

The majority of your coursework in this program will be completed at the SSA Center. In addition, you will enroll in one course at the Universidad de Sevilla (USEV), where you will study alongside other SSA participants as well as international students.

After consulting with your school's academic advisor, choose courses according to the following guidelines.

Prerequisites:

1. Minimum 2.5 GPA
2. Successful completion of one course of intermediate college-level Spanish or the equivalent

Instructions:

1. You must preregister for a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 18 credits.
2. You must preregister for one course at the Universidad de Sevilla.
3. If you preregister for SPAN 204 -
 - o It is highly recommended that you also register for SPAN 305B as the next step in your Spanish language development.
 - o You are encouraged to enroll in one or more of the following content courses: SPAN 303/304, SPAN 317/318, SPAN 326, SPAN 347, or SOCI 351. These courses are specifically tailored to your level of Spanish and are designed to further develop your language skills while deepening your understanding of Spanish language and culture.
4. SSA and Universidad de Sevilla reserve the right to cancel courses due to low enrollment.
